MINUTES OF August 20, 1984, were approved as written on MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

REPORT for August was accepted upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative TREASURER'S vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #257 and #501 through #584 and #701 through #709 totaling \$771,700.73 less #12 for \$97.

> August payrolls were: Regular: \$524,994.06

Work Study: \$ 13,280.58

A MOTION by Dr. Scholes approved the disbursements and transfer of funds and acknowledged the August payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS: Twenty scholarships totaling \$3650 for the fall semester, six scholarships totaling \$850 for the spring semester, five loans totaling \$450, and one emergency loan totaling \$300 were all approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman.

A bid was let to Colonial Concrete of Twin Falls to construct an BID: access road from the college loop to the physical education building.

BUILDING PLANS: President Meyerhoeffer indicated that he would be presenting plans to the board in the near future for construction of the addition to the Taylor Building.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Jerry Meyerhoeffer reported the following:

- 1. For the first time in the history of the College of Southern Idaho, the State Board of Education has prioritized one of our building requests. They have recommended to the Permanent Building Fund Council a \$100,000 appropriation to start the plans for a new agriculture-science building on campus.
- 2. Brian Chase, Administrator of the Public Works Division, was on campus last week reviewing the campus buildings. The college will now be considered for major maintenance on campus buildings to come from the Permanent Building Fund.
- 3. DOE grant for retrofit of the Taylor Administration Building has been received.
- 4. One of the above mainentance of current operation requests to the State Board of Education was for retrofit of the Vo-Tech Building. The State Board turned it down as a budget item indicating their approval for taking it to the Permanent Building Fund Council.
- 5. We received a letter from Marty Peterson, Administrator, Division of Financial Management in the Office of the Governor, wherein he had asked the State Board to sit down and work out an annual funding formula for the community colleges.
- 6. During the second semester the college intends to offer a weekend college wherein students may take a course of study on Friday nights and Saturdays.

PUBLIC INPUT: Debbie Schmeckel presented a petition to the board asking that they release Jerry Meyerhoeffer as president of the college. Others speaking at the meeting were Douglas Bashaw, Ben Bartlett, Gary Loomis, Rev. At the request of Jack Sims, the chairman of the board called an executive session excluding everyone except the board of trustees and Jack Sims. Following the executive session, the chairman of the board ruled the meeting closed.
