COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING September 17, 1975

CALL TO ORDER: 8:05 p.m. PRESIDING: LeRoy Craig

MINUTES of AUGUST 18, 1975, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for AUGUST, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #262 including 33A, 135A and 167A, totaling \$106,661.08; fund transfers covered by vouchers #263 through #269 amounted to \$52, 312.17.

August payrolls were: Regular \$195,523.19; Work Study \$15,227.46.

A MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Dr. Lehrman, approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the August payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: Employment of Ronald Spann, Kara Knodel, and John Watland was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

EXPOSITION CENTER: Change Order #2, with alternative A & B had been signed by Dr. Taylor. The change order cost \$34,034.50. Mr. Al Peters of the Twin Falls Canal Co. has written a letter expressing satisfaction with the correction of the water problem. The board's approval was moved by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Nine scholarships totaling \$400 and one loan for \$200 were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor reported that considerable time had been spent preparing the budget for FY 77. It has now been submitted to the State Department of Higher Education. The budget will be considered by the State Board of October 22. We have asked for \$108,000 for repairs or replacement of the roofs on the Fine Arts and Shields buildings as a first priority after our maintenance of current operations budget.

Construction of the new vo tech building is progressing well. It will provide in excess of 90,000 sq. ft. of space. In the project we will also be able to extend the campus road to the north end of the campus. The city and county still assure us that the north boundary road will be opened this fall.

Final figures are not available on enrollment, but we are sure enrollment is up. Over 100 students attended a home improvement course which started last week.

Exposition Center construction is starting to progress. They have a good start on the walls on three sides of the building. If weather is good we still hope to get the roof on before winter.

Dr. Taylor will be meeting with the Higher Commission on September 24, 25 and 26, in Seattle. They will consider a merger of the Western and Northwestern Accrediting Association. The Higher Commission was very impressed with our campus during their meeting in Twin Falls.
