MINUTES OF DECEMBER 19, 1977, were approved as written upon MOTION by
Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote
unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for December 1977, was accepted upon MOTION by
Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote
unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #251 totaling \$251,284.00;
fund transfers covered by vouchers #252 through #259 amounted
to \$41,408.73.

December payrolls were: Regular \$266,305.34

Work/Study \$ 13,179.64

A MOTION by Mr. Blastock seconded by Mr. Coleman approved the
disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the
December payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS: The attached scholarships were approved on MOTION by
Mr. Babcock, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote
unanimous.

TRANSFER: A request from David M. Kees of 653 Blue Lakes, Twin Falls to
North Idaho to study in their Forestry Program, was approved
on MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative
vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Last Monday we held our In-service workshop for faculty
in preparation for the new semester. Dr. Taylor spent most of
the rest of the week in Boise. He reported some difficulty in
getting the State Board of Education to recognize the needs of
the junior colleges. He also reported that he felt that he had
received a good response from the Joint Appropriation Committee
and is optimistic about some increase in funds over the State


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Board and the Governor's recommendation to the legislature.

It appears that enrollment for the second semester will hold up well. As you know the Fall semester increase was about 11.8 percent over last year.

Dr. Taylor expressed some concern that any agency of the State now, is being asked to have any application for federal funds to be approved on a state level, before the application is made to the federal government.




