MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 16, 1981 were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock, MOTION carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT for February was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Hamilton, MOTION Carried.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #277 and #501 through #605 totaling \$1,270,290.48; including 601A fund transfers covered by vouchers #278 through #284 amounted to \$9,823.44.

February payrolls were: Regular \$402,393.00

Work/Study \$ 12,516.72

A MOTION by Mr. Blastock approved the disbursements and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the February payrolls. MOTION Carried.

TUITION AND FEES: A tuition increase of 12½% and a fee increase of \$15 per semester, beginning with the Fall Semester 1981, were approved on MOTION by Mr. Hamilton. MOTION Carried.

BOARD AND ROOM: An increase of appoximately 8% in meal charges according to the attached schedule, was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. MOTION Carried.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS: Two scholarships of \$50 each were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. MOTION Carried.

RE-EMPLOYMENT: Dr. Taylor submitted a list of employees that he would recommend for re-employment for the 1981-82 School Year. He indicated that the name of Lloyd Hardesty and Jim Walker were on the list and should not be at this time. Re-employment of those listed was approved on MOTION by Mr. Blastock. MOTION carried.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor reported that the college has had a successful basketball season and was highly complimentary of Coach Dave Campbell.

The Vocational Building under construction is approximately 65% complete, June 1 has been set as completion date.

The geothermal well is at about the 1200 ft. level.

Dr. Taylor is going ahead with plans for construction of an amphitheater near the Museum. He has indicated that there will be student support for the project and that he has had a commitment for concrete venders who would be willing to make sizeable contributions, as well as others who are interested in contributing.

The Fodder Beet Program has run tests on the fodder beets that are approaching 20% sugar content. In spite of the fact that a scientist recently reported that the fodder beet is not a good beet for sugar content.

The still for processing the sugar beet into fuel is nearing completion.

The college has been moving trees to other areas of the campus for landscaping.

There have been several recent events in the Expo Center, including the Angus Show and Sale, the Polled Hereford Show and Sale and the Swine Show and Sale.

Dr. Taylor reported that we will continue Summer School this summer.

The water source in the South Hills for propagation of fish does not look good for this summer. Dr. Taylor indicated that a spring north of the river looks favorable and they are moving fish to that area.
