Dear Student:

The U.S. Department of Education regulations require each recipient of Federal Financial Aid funds to certify that they have registered for Selective Service. The College of Southern Idaho Student Financial Office has received your FAFSA electronically and realized that you have not yet turned 18. In order to comply with regulations you must notify our office with proof that you have registered for Selective Service when you turn 18. If you do not, and are awarded Federal Financial Aid you will be required to pay back all money that you have received.
