Guidelines for Awarding

West End Men's Association Scholarships

Applicants must have graduated from a school in the Buhl School District. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE LIMITED TO PERSONS PLANNING TO PURSUE OR CONTINUING A COLLEGE OR POST-HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION IN IDAHO

Applicants may only qualify for one scholarship. Previous WEMA scholarship recipients will be rejected.

Applicants must be a graduate of Buhl High School, Wakapa Academy, or Clear Lakes Christian Academy planning to attend a college or technical school for higher education in Idaho. Students that have attended the Buhl School District and have graduated with a GED are also eligible to apply. Applicants need to be registered as full time students in order to qualify and maintain the scholarship.

The West End Men's Association Scholarship Committee has the flexibility and discretion to grant scholarships based on merit and financial need. Scholarship recommendations by the Committee are subject to approval by the West End Men's Association.

Applications must be complete, neatly organized, and signed to be considered. A current transcript of the applicant's high school and college grades (if applicable) must be included with the application. Well thought out responses to questions will show the selection committee you have put extra effort into your application and could earn you a scholarship.

When a scholarship is awarded, the money will be transmitted directly to the institution the recipient is currently attending or planning to attend. The awardee's account at the institution will be credited. Failure to attend will result in revocation of the scholarship. Recipients of WEMA scholarships are eligible to receive only one scholarship during their pursuit of higher education.

All scholarship applications are due by April 1. Completed applications should be returned to your school counselors office or submitted to Vince Hamilton at the Buhl Branch of Farmers Bank.
