Health & Wellness

- Counseling: Free to enrolled students. CSI Counseling Services offers Licensed Professional Counselors to help our students take the best care of their emotional and mental health. Counseling Services | CSI - College of Southern Idaho

- Student Health Services (Medical Support): CSI contracts with Physicians Immediate Care Center (PICC) to offer some basic health care services to current full-time and part-time students who are enrolled in credit courses and have paid their tuition and fees in full or have entered into a Tuition Loan Agreement with CSI. <u>Student Health</u> <u>Services | CSI - College of Southern Idaho</u>

Transportation

Educational Support

- Tutoring: CSI's Learning and Tutoring Commons provides all CSI students, including Dual Credit students, with great educational support.
