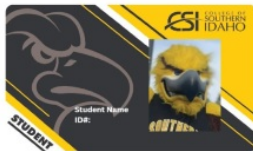


WHERE CAN YOU UPGRADE?

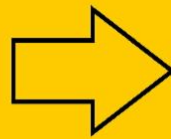
