



Cook ground beef and onion, drain. Add tomatoes, breaking them up into smaller pieces. Add dried ingredients, herbs and rice. Add beef broth. Bring to a boil, then reduce to a simmer for about 45 minutes. Add macaroni and continue cooking until peas, barley, lentil and macaroni are tender. Makes 16 servings




