





The Prize

Evaluation Criteria

Submissions will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Eligibility Requirements

Student must be enrolled at a NISOD member college for the spring semester to participate

Students must be at least 18 years old by May 2025.

The faculty, staff member, or administrator written about in the essay must currently be employed by the college.

The student and the faculty, staff member, or administrato written about in the essay must be able to travel to Austin to participate in the Student Essay Contest presentation held during NISOD's annual conference.

 Submission deadline: March 7, 2025
 Winners noffled: March 21, 2025
 Winner acceptance due: April 4, 2025
 Prize presented and essay read at NISOD conference: May 25, 2025




